

FORENSIC CUSTODY EXPERTS AND RELATED PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

In March of 1998, I had the privilege of serving on a committee established by the Burlington County Bar Association Family Law Bench/Bar Committee to review and update the list of court appointed experts for purposes of custody evaluations. Christopher R. Stockton, Esquire, Karen L. Amacker, Esquire, Susan R. Dargay, Esquire, Patrick Judge Jr., Esquire, Diane Talty, MSW, Andrew Musetto, PhD and other individuals spent the better part of a year and a half interviewing different experts and investigating the process of custody evaluators, the CAN program, parenting coordinators and other professional services related to family law matters. We ultimately prepared a report including a list of approved custody experts, protocol for engagement as forensic custody experts, standards for the CAN, standards for risk assessments and other criteria.

As the Chair of the Custody and Visitation Sub-Committee, I am organizing a committee to review the custody experts list as well as the work of our prior committee to update and improve our previous efforts. I would also greatly appreciate the names, addresses and phone numbers of those psychologists, MSW's, clinicians, or other qualified individuals with regard to forensic custody evaluations, custody neutral assessments, risk assessments, parenting coordinator services and other related professions.

It is our intention to create a new list of court appointed custody experts, review the existing custody and parenting time mediation program, review the existing CNA program, review the parenting coordinator program and also explore various ancillary and complimentary professional services.

I look forward to receiving your emails. After receiving the emails, I anticipate scheduling a meeting of the membership of the custody/visitation/support sub-committee for purposes of reviewing the commentary of the bar and commencing the process of scheduling professionals for interviews.
